

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-056

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SAN BUENAVENTURA , CALIFORNIA,  
RATIFYING AND EXTENDING PROCLAMATION  
OF LOCAL HEALTH EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.370 of the San Buenaventura Municipal Code empowers the Director of Disaster Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the City is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the City Council is not in session, subject to ratification by the City Council; and,

WHEREAS, conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within this City by a fire and wind event, i.e., the Thomas fire, commencing on or about 10:00 pm on the fourth day of December 2017 at which time the City Council of the City of San Buenaventura was not in session; and,

WHEREAS, City Council has found that the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril do warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Disaster Services did proclaim the existence of a local emergency within said City on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 2017 at 10:05 pm; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to his authority under Health and Safety Code section 101080, the Health Officer of Ventura County, in conjunction with the Director of the Ventura County Environmental Health Division, a duly authorized deputy local health officer, proclaimed the existence of a local health emergency in Ventura County on December 8, 2017, arising from the Thomas fire and other wildfires in the neighboring counties of Los Angeles and Santa Barbara impacting Ventura County; and,

WHEREAS, the local health emergency proclamation by the Health Officer of Ventura County is applicable to this jurisdiction, and the Ventura County Board of Supervisors will consider whether to ratify and extend the proclamation of a local health emergency on December 12, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has been informed and hereby finds that there continues to be a local health emergency within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Buenaventura does hereby resolve, find, determine and order as follows:

Section 1: The proclamation of the Health Officer of Ventura County of a local health emergency on December 8, 2017, is hereby ratified.

Section 2: A local health emergency continues to exist within the City due to the Thomas fire and other wildfires in the neighboring counties of Los Angeles and Santa Barbara impacting Ventura County and the City and shall be deemed to continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by City Council.
