SYSTEMS, AND MATERIALS FOR THE **MEMBRANE BIOREACTOR/ULTRAVIOLET** LIGHT DISINFECTION PROJECT AND THE PROJECTS THAT COMPRISE THE VENTURAWATERPURE PROGRAM

SECTION 1: It is in the City's best interest and the City Council hereby authorizes the use of best value selection for the purchase of equipment, systems, and materials for the Membrane Bioreactor/Ultraviolet Light Disinfection Project and the projects that comprise the VenturaWaterPure Program.
